

Medical Equipment Policy

Any medical equipment that is required for the means of medical support is permitted at Community Action of South Mississippi. Items must be considered 'Necessary Medical Items', such as:

- Portable oxygen tank
- Life vest (defibrillators)
- Heart Monitor
- Ambulatory walker, wheelchair, cane, etc.

Persons using our transportation services may bring a respirator, portable oxygen, and/or other life support equipment on board our vehicles, as long as they do not violate the law or rules relating to the transportation of hazardous materials.

- All equipment must be small enough to fit into our vehicles safely and without obstructing the aisle and/or block emergency exits.
- CASOMS can accommodate passengers in their mobility device that fall within the size and weight range for which the vehicle is manufactured.
- CASOMS will only accommodate wheelchairs that can be safely loaded and transported.

Community Action of South Mississippi will not be responsible for any damage to equipment. Medical equipment cannot be left at CASOMS, on the bus, or any other vehicle at any time.
